Middle Palisade. Two 22-year-olds who met a guy online and they decided to climb Middle Palisade and were in over their heads. Turned around 100' before the summit just as it got dark. Julie got to be lowered down to them and sent them all out on the helicopter.

Mine rescue training in Darwin: Jack the miner man, brought them into the hut full of mouse poop where they did not sleep but had to sit in class for 4 hours the next day. Then they all went in one of the mines which was fascinating, but the takeaway from the weekend was if we had a mine rescue call, we would call the San Bernardino Mine and Cave rescue team.
