October 7, 2017

Call to Order The Inyo SAR general meeting was held at the Posse Hut and was called to order at 7:06 pm by Elsbeth Otto.

## Mission and Training Reports

- Missing Person White Mountains Woman went missing while picking Pine Nuts up in the White Mountains. One team of four went up to try and find her that night, and did not find anything. The next morning, team members went out and searched along with a helicopter. The woman was found about half a mile from the point last seen. Subject was evacuated via wheeled litter.
- Cal MRA Meeting CA Region had a monthly meeting at the Posse Hut. A few members attended. Noteworthy items—notification system that will alert teams within the region of an upcoming mutual aid request. Ventura SAR is planning for the Rock Certification in March in the Alabama Hills near Lone Pine.
- Thursday Training Darla brought veggies to share. Went over vacuum split, packaging for high angle rescue.
- **Tech Training** Buttermilks. Set anchors, lowered, raised to practice high angle rescue.
- Golden Lake/Pine Creek Local 75 YO woman got snowed in up on Pine Creek. Husband hired a packer, got himself inserted. Initial callout said that there was a 80 YO man with a heart attack. A team of Inyo SAR members went up with warm gear, oxygen, and an AED. Turned out they were weak from the cold, no immediate heart attack like reported. CHP H82 helicopter landed in the morning and evacuated the pair.
