Base jumper at Lower Boy Scout Lake – Fatality, “speed flyer”, jumped from cliff above Lower Boy Scout, helo evacuation.

Med and Purcell prusik training – Demoed vacuum mattress, oxygen training, tied Purcell prusiks.

Lion King Rock training – Scenario: two subjects - stranded climber, injured climber. Did BC pick-off of stranded climber, treated injured climber, did two litter lowers, one with main and belay, one with mirrored system.
