- 3. Missions and trainings.
 - a. 10/?? Haystack (base of Inyo Mountains, east of Lone Pine). Dean C. and Max G.
 Female subject was rockhounding, startled by snake, fell, and broke her arm. Packaged injury, and initiated carryout with patient in litter. Calfire showed up. Lone Pine Fire showed up. Patient transferred to ambulance.
 - b. 10/8 Cliffed out in Buttermilk (Morning Light Wall). Male subject got separated from party descending East Ridge of Mt. Humphreys. Lane D. was lowered to subject from H-40. Hoisted male subject out. Subject initially didn't want to be hoisted because he was concerned about getting charged for rescue.
 - c. 10/14 Ledged out on Whitney. Paul R. Male subject on Mountaineer's Route, climbed rock on right, got stuck. SEKI helicopter pulled them out next morning. Team on standby at LP Airport.
 - d. 10/19 Knot tying and anchoring rodeo. Led by Todd V. Thursday night in hut. Knots, anchoring, MA rigging. Well attended and well run.
 - e. 10/21 John Dill lecture. Two lectures on search management. How long can search subjects survive? Murphy never sleeps. Bonus lecture: helicopter operations on big walls.
 - f. 10/21 Broken leg on Mountaineer's Route. Party of four, female sustained open lower leg fracture to her. Minor injuries to male. He fell and pulled her off and they took a fall of unknown length. H-40 inserted Dave P. and Bob H. at Iceberg Lake. Hard snow/ice in gully. Used Sked and vacuum splint to package. Single rope lowers, seven or eight pitches. NAS Lemoore attempted night landing at Iceberg but couldn't. Carried to Iceberg and H-40 picked up in morning. PSAR issues. Single rope lower issues. Todd V.: we should always arrange hands-free backup on single line lowers.
