September Trainings and Missions

- South Lake Heart Attack Heart attack about 3/4 mile up the trail in South Lake. Two CalFire units, Forest Service were already on scene. Inyo SAR assisted with carryout and packaging.
- Hut Night Hut got cleaned up and sorted. There was a dumpster of stuff thrown away. An all-hands-on-deck effort to make the hut tidy!
- South Lake Patient Packaging Training Split into two teams to practice packaging a patient in a high-angle rescue situation. One team practiced packaging with the Sked and the other with a conventional litter, both with vacuum splints.
- Whitney E Ledges 45 YO male stuck on the E Ledges overnight. Two Inyo SAR members set up three belays to help the victim down to the trail.
- South Lake, Bishop Pass Search Missing 63 YO female disappeared while backpacking near Bishop Pass. She got lost on Bishop Pass, and ended up getting lost on the way down near the Chocolate Lakes. She ended up safe and sound, appearing at the trailhead.
